## **To consider the allocation of funding for skate park improvements up to £5000**

The following is a report from Councillor Ward on the Community Investment Panel meeting where Kirkbymoorside Ward funding was considered.

*“I presented the panel with a summary of the participatory budget approach and a list of all the applications with the votes given to each project. I also presented to the panel the views of KMS Town Council regarding its disappointment that on the results of the community event so little funding would be available for KMS parish and specifically for the skate park, and how enthusiastic the young people had been for this project. The panel members had all heard me speak about the need for funding for the skate park at the last full council meeting and although I wasn't successful at getting any funding at that meeting, there was support for the proposal this evening.*

*The panel was conscious though that making a decision to fund the skate park would go against the result of the participatory budgeting. It was agreed therefore to contact the Town Council and Wombledon Parish Council to ask if both projects could go ahead if the funding was shared between them. This would mean that each project could receive £4,541”*

The Play Areas committee is keenly aware of the importance of the skate park to young people in the town and would like to see the proposed improvements completed as soon as possible. The cost of the work is in the region of £10,000 and the annual amount allocated to the play areas in the Town Council's budget is insufficient to fund the project. Until the CIF panel meets in March we do not know if Kirkbymoorside will receive any funding at all. It is therefore proposed that £2000 be allocated from the Play Areas 2011/2012 budget, and councillors are asked to support the provision of up to £5000 from council funds to allow some improvements to be made to the skate park.

## **To consider commissioning a legal review of the council's employment documents**
