Hellifield used a community led plan to attract funding to their village. They were able to turn a church hall into a youth facility. This has since grown into a community cafe.

Hovingham Village Hall improved their facilities and upgraded their kitchen. Now they have an award-winning monthly market with an extremely successful community cafe.

Since its start, over £20,000 has been raised and ploughed back into the local community.

Saltburn Methodist Hall had an energy audit and received help with business planning and funding. They then replaced their boiler and introduced energy efficient lighting. The hall is now an inviting place to meet.
