Provide a detailed description of the project evidence of the need for your project, and show who will benefit from it	To provide and maintain a defibrillator machine, which will be available for use by both Kirkbymoorside School and also the general public. It will be located at the bottom of the school path, close to the main school gate and to West Fields road. The school gate is always open, so members of the public will be able to access the machine at all times. Whilst there are defib machines located at the golf club and the bowling
	club, they are both a sited a long way from school, and are not likely to be accessed in time in the event of an emergency. Furthermore, children require special paediatric pads to be used with a defib machine, which deliver a reduced strength shock. Our defib machine will be able to serve both children and adults. School staff and other interested parties will be trained to use the machine, and they will able to assist if any member of public needs to use the machine. The machine is also capable of being used with no training, as it gives audio and visual instructions.
	The machine will be well signed, to draw attention to its presence, and we will also advertise locally that it is available for use by all. We will do this by, for example, advertising this on our Facebook page, and on other local Facebook pages, on the KMS blog, in the Go Local magazine, and on the school website.

	Kirkbymoorside School currently has around 235 pupils, plus staff. It is situated in a densely populated area, being close to both the new Manor Woods housing estate, and West Pasture. It is also just a few minutes to the busy Market Place. The machine would therefore be able to serve a large percentage of the Kirkbymoorside population.
What are the full costs of the project (including VAT if applicable)	Defib machine approx £1200 External cabinet to house the machine approx £500 Signage approx £50 Training courses for using the machine approx £1,500 Total initial cost approx £3,250 Ongoing maintenance costs are between £30 and £200 per year, depending on whether the machine has been used or not. There will also be periodic further training costs, due to future school staff changes, with new staff needing training.

(Tell us the funder and the amount you expect from them)	We hope to receive funding of £2000 from the KMS Town Council to go towards the purchase of the machine, and will fund the remainder of the purchase cost from our own existing funds. We will also commit to providing our own funds to fully cover the cost of ongoing maintenance and training.



12 MONTH FORWARD PLAN

- Our project is very straightforward and therefore it follows that our 12 month plan is also very simple.
- As soon as we have secured funding, we will purchase the defib machine, external cabinet, and signage. We will install the machine as soon as it arrives. We expect to be able to do this within 1 month of the funding being received. The machine can be used by anyone, with no training, so it is important that we make it available for use as soon as possible after it is purchased.
- Once the machine has been installed, we will publicise its availability. We will do this straight away.
- Although the machine can be used without training, for the best chance of success we want to provide training to school staff and other interested parties. The timescale for this is dependent on places on training courses being available, and on the ability of school being to release staff in order to attend the courses. Clearly the staff will not all be able to attend the same course, and training will need to be staged. St Johns Ambulance runs courses at Leeds and Harrogate. We aim to have been able to place all the relevant individuals on courses within 12 months of purchase of the machine.
- It is therefore our aim that the main project is completed within 12 months of receiving the funding.
- We will continue to provide funding to cover maintenance and training costs on an ongoing basis.
