PUBLIC RESPONSE

- Regarding the current consultation around the installation of CCTV at the park, I would highly recommend the installation of CCTV; this would not only act as a visual deterrent but also emphasise to local residents, namely parents/guardians, that Ryedale Council are doing everything they can to make Kirkbymoorside a safer place for young children to play and socialise.
- Whilst I think that a full-time PCSO would be a better idea for addressing the low level nuisance issues in Town the provision of CCTV might be a good idea.
- I have cleared up litter, broken glass etc. In the play area on a number of occasions and have been saddened at the continued repetition of such littering behaviour. The appearance of graffiti and damage to installations is also an issue.
- Clearly this evidence of antisocial behaviour is down to a small minority of people and if needs CCTV to identify and deter them then regretfully I am in favour.
- We don't have a problem at all with there being CCTV cameras at the park.
- I am in favour of CCTV monitoring in the children's play area. To help reduce anti social behaviour and keep our children safe.
- You have our support with the installation of the CCTV at the playground. I've been taking my kids to the park for years and recently found more bottles, rubbish and broken equipment there than ever before. A friend of mine had a teenager try to steal her 5 years olds scooter whilst he was using it a few months ago.

Hopefully the CCTV will make the area feel safer and more relaxed for families of all ages.

- I think it's a shame it's needed but I think cctv is a good idea to prevent antisocial behaviour.
I hope it would act as a deterrent and not something else to wreck.
