



species, are known to breed. The current issues with sewage pollution to this area are a matter of record.

In the current climate it is unlikely that Yorkshire Water will put new sewage and pipe work in place to manage these site issues and in the past 18 months there have been serious issues with the removal of waste water from the area around the Ambulance Station, necessitating the use of tankers, as well as localised flooding.

I am sure the Town Council will raise the matters of the local infrastructure, schools and medical services which are struggling to meet the needs of the current population but it may not be aware of the erosion of NHS services to residents north of the Howardian Hills and particularly this region, that are already taking place. The withdrawal of services has been drawn to the attention of the local MP and is awaiting a response from the Health Department. (Copy attached)
