11. To receive correspondence from Ryedale Open Studios and consider the contribution of up to £800 to facilitate the Kirkbymoorside Art Club

Dear Town Council,

There is an exciting & new initiative for young people recently established in Kirkbymoorside, which needs funding in order to continue.

Art Club is part of Vault Arts in Kirkby. Vault Arts is now going into our third year of organising/running & funding Ryedale Open Studios - below is a summary of 3 months worth of bank statements. We do not have audited accounts as we are a micro entity & that isn't required. However we are a not for profit organisation CIC, please see below recent Confirmation Statement filed with Companies House.

As Ryedale Open Studios grows and continues to excel (we have more artists than ever before signed up for 2023, with many new & graduate artists, which is fantastic) we want to start to build a legacy and have positive community impact.

Art Club is a weekly 2 hour workshop that offers a safe creative space for 13-16 year olds. The workshops are led by professional artists, all facilitators are DBS cleared.

We secured a £250 grant from Ryedale Lions to get Art Club off the ground, the weekly breakdown of costs is as follows:

Studio space for 8	£30
Artist fee.	£50
Materials.	£20
	£100

We ask each young person to pay £5 per session, we have had an average of 4 young people, bringing us an income of £20 per week, leaving funding to cover the remaining £80.

There is no other service for young people in Kirkby and we have already established links with local neighbourhood police and Ryedale School Art Department, who are fully supportive of this service. If we can stem the rise of antisocial behaviour in Kirkby by offering an affordable, engaging & safe space, then all the better.

The initial funding had allowed us to test the viability of Art Club & review its need and the results have been fantastic & we invite you to visit and observe any of the sessions. Not only do the young people have a creative environment in which to thrive and grow, they are developing transferable life skills, including time management, project development, self confidence & communication skills. There is nothing like this for the community for 13-16 in Kirkby.

The current funding means we can run Art Club until 19th June 2023.

Creative skills support mental health & wellbeing and the benefits of the arts in this area is well documented. The pandemic has had a significant impact on limiting the experiences of all young

people, and although we live in a beautiful rural area, this can be limiting by restricting the experiences that are available without travel.

Art club offers an affordable opportunity for artistic & creative workshops for young people in a time of significant financial hardship.

We would be grateful for any financial contribution you were able to make. However a contribution of at least £800 would allow for Art Club to continue for 10 weeks, over the summer period.

We have applied for longer term funding from the NYCC prosperity fund, however we have been informed there is a backlog in processing applications.
