11. To note due warranty expiry of the defibrillator at the sports field and consider the replacement cost of £850 + VAT with a 7 year warranty



green indicates the lantern is on all night

North Yorkshire Council Street Lighting Part Night Photocell Selection Criteria:

A Street light can be part night lit provided NONE of these criteria applies:

- 1. Main traffic routes and road junctions.
- 2. Significant nighttime RTCs.
- 3. Hazards: traffic calming, bumps & crossings (except 20mph) e.g. chicanes, build-outs, but not traffic islands.
- 4. Town centers with nighttime activity.
- 5. Council or Police CCTV operational areas.
- 6. 24-hour operational emergency services (including hospitals).
- 7. Lights outside registered sheltered accommodation & warden controlled accommodation
- 8. Significant relevant nighttime crime or anti-social behavior.
- 9. Wayfinders.
- 10. Not Adopted yet.

Recommendation by Mike Hawtin, Head of Nature Recovery Projects, North York Moors National Park Authority, in the interest of supporting Dark Skies, is part night lighting which goes off at midnight and back on at 5am.

New legislation known as High Street Rental Auctions is expected to be in force later this year. The new power will give councils the right to auction off the leases of persistently vacant commercial properties on high streets for up to five years.
