9. To consider making representation to North Yorkshire Council Highways Authority with regards to safety concerns for pedestrians at the junction of Howe End and Piercy End/Market Place.

Vehicles mounting the pavement

Reported via desktop in the Roads/highways category anonymously at 20:29, Monday 25 November 2024
Sent to North Yorkshire Council less than a minute later. FixMyStreet ref: 6783869.



At the junction of Howe End and Market Place, Kirkbymoorside, the road on the left hand side of Howe End (when turning into it from Market Place) is very narrow. If there are vehicle waiting at the junction of Howe End to exit the road, vehicles entering use the dropped kerb on the corner to mount the pavement in order to get past them due to the road's narrowness (rather than wait). Anyone exiting the shop / offices on the corner of Howe End step into the path on the oncoming vehicle. There have been some very close near misses. A bollard at the pavement edge just after the dropped kerb would prevent this dangerous behaviour.

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Response from North Yorkshire Council:

Thank you for requesting a bollard on Howe End.

Your case reference number is: 101010774729.

I have passed your report to our local area highways office. An officer will usually carry out an inspection within five working days.

The timeframe for reported faults to be resolved depends upon the priority of the road, the level of risk to road users, work load and weather conditions. In some cases, the issue may not meet the criteria for intervention, which means it will be reviewed during routine inspections and will not receive immediate attention. Where a fault has been recognised as a standard defect, we aim to repair within 90 working days. We will be able to offer an update to reported faults within 20 working days of the report being received by highways. Please be advised due to high demand, highways professionals are not able to respond to customer requests directly.

If the issue is causing an immediate danger to the safety of road users, it is classified as an emergency. You should contact us by telephone on 0300 131 2 131 to report an emergency rather than using our online form. Our opening hours are Monday, Tuesday and Thursday 9am - 5pm, Wednesday 9.30am - 5pm and Friday 9am - 4.30pm. Dial 999 outside office hours for our emergency service.

I would also recommend speaking to your local parish council regarding your request as this will provide your request a stronger backing if you can get their support. You can pass your reference number to the Parish Council so they can pass their support onto ourselves.
