Our walking group, working alongside the Kirkbymoorside Next Steps initiative, operates for 51 weeks of the year, and the response has been overwhelmingly positive.</p> <p>We provide walk sessions to assist disabled people and have dedicated volunteers who help run the sessions. Our minibs and volunteer drivers transport approximately 20-25 local residents each week to beautiful locations around Kirkbymoorside, where we conduct an inclusive walk varying from 2-5 miles, walk and talk sessions.</p> <p>These walks are designed to support individuals who feel isolated or lonely, encourage physical exercise, improve physical and mental health, and foster friendships and positive relationships. Everyone is welcome, and we take the opportunity to discuss personal, local, and global issues positively.</p> <p>Our group includes individuals who are partially sighted, disabled, elderly, and people of all ages. Together, we share a wonderful experience while enhancing our well-being. The group is led by a qualified, trained worker and supported by six volunteers, making it a significant success in the community.</p> <p>On return from our sessions the group congregate back at the hub where we provide homemade meals and refreshments and access to our other support session, IT support and activities.</p>
