I'm getting in touch on behalf of the Kirkbymoorside 10k committee. The 10k event takes place on Sunday 3rd May next year and arrangements are already in progress.

On behalf of the Kirkby 10K committee I would like to say a very big thank you for supporting the event this year by paying for the traffic management, we really do appreciate it. As you know all profits from the event went to Friends of Kirkbymoorside School and the Friends of Gillamoor School so your contribution meant that more money could go to the charities. Having you on board also was very re-assuring as running the event is becoming more and more expensive and lots of cost have to be committed to before we even start taking money for entries.

I am sure that again there will be thousands of people in Kirkbymoorside for 10K in 2026 for what we hope will be another fantastic day. We have instructed Community Traffic Management to organise the traffic management for 2026 and they have sent an invoice/quote – which is £40 more than last year but everything else remains the same.
