Information for the meeting on Monday 20 July 2026

11. To consider the requests by the Kirkbymoorside Community Support Group to:

- a. transfer ownership to the Town Council of flags and flagpoles used to promote and enhance the town and town events, approximated asset value of £4,000.**
- b. transfer of responsibility for the seasonal installation and subsequent removal of flag poles and flags, approximated annual cost of £600**
- c. storage of flags and flagpoles between seasons**

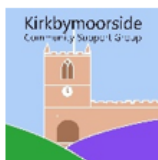
Due to resources (once grant funding runs out), and health issues, I'd be grateful if the Town Council would consider from next year (2027) 'taking over' the responsibility for the seasonal installation and removal of town brand and music festival flags and flag poles (designed to fit into Christmas tree holders) and the storage of them in between seasons. Ownership of the resources would pass to the Town Council from the Kirkbymoorside Community Support Group.

Contractor costs (to put up and take down flag and flag poles, would be in the region of £600 a year: this year that is covered by the grant, but we have no funding for it next year. The new flag poles made by RACK Systems cannot be dismantled for storage, and the flags have been sewn onto rotation tubes (so can't just be folded up) and there is not room in my loft to store them now (plus we're not well enough to climb up into it) and I have no other storage available.

I think you'd agree they enhance the town and the visitor experience, and it would be a shame after all the time, money and effort that has gone into them not to continue to use them!
