URGENT – amended Register of Interests form template and supporting guidance

Regarding legislative changes about the publication of councillors' usual residential addresses, the Monitoring Officer has revised the template parish/town council interests form template and supporting guidance.

The new template interests form consists of two parts:

- A. **Part A** – a private frontsheet for the Clerk and Monitoring Officer to retain confidentially; and
- B. **Part B** – the public interests form for publication in the Register of Members' Interests.

Both parts should be completed as appropriate and returned to the Clerk and to the Monitoring Officer. Full details about completing both parts are included in the attached guidance and on the forms themselves, which councillors should read carefully.

At its meeting on 15 July 2026, North Yorkshire Council is reviewing its Members' Code of Conduct to reflect the change in registration of interests' requirements regarding councillors' usual residential addresses. The report and proposed changes to the Code are published here:
