## PUBLIC FOOTPATH AT BACK OF WAINDS FIELD TRILANDIUM DEVELOPMENT

Andrew Hall has passed this to his colleague Ben Jackson (Countryside Assess Officer) at NYCC who will be in negotiations with Trilandium whose responsibility it it to reinstate the footpath as closure ceased on 5<sup>th</sup> May. Email dated 23/04/13:

Wainds Field Development site. There is a temporary closure in place for the Public Footpaths running through the site. The closure expires on 5<sup>th</sup> May and will not be extended. I have made enquiries, and Ryedale District Council have made & confirmed a permanent diversion of the 2 paths involved (under the Town & Country Planning Act 1990, as part of this development.)

It would seem that the developer (Trilandium Homes) still has some work to do on the new paths, before the diversion order can be certified for public use. I am awaiting some information from the legal team at Ryedale, but I will have a look on site on Thursday morning when I meet Mr Hall re: point 2.

Ben Jackson will be meeting Catherine from Trilandium at Wainds Field development on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May at 1.30pm. Progress with the diversion of the footpath and reinstatement of the public footpath will be provided regularly.

#### THE SHAMBLES
