COMMUNITY AWARD

At the Annual Town meeting held in The Moorside Room on 3 May 2022 the Town Mayor, Nick Holroyd presented the Community Award to Helen Gundry and John Warriner.



Helen was nominated by friends and members of the Kirkbymoorside Environment Group and Northern Ryedale Public Transport Group. For many years, Helen has worked unceasingly on improving the local bus services and creating a safe cycle track/footpath along the A170. The survival of the summer Moorsbus service is entirely due to her perseverance. Helen is also responsible for the 'Path for Everyone' project, which is intended to provide a cycle track from Kirkbymoorside to Helmsley.

Helen has also made a significant contribution to the community through her voluntary work with the Kirkbymoorside Environment Group. She has been responsible for initiating a number of climate change projects, for example the 'Give or Take days', encouraging people to re-use and recycle and the 'Thermal Imaging Camera' project increasing household energy saving.

Thanks to Helen for this considerable contribution to the community.



John was nominated by friends and fellow members of the Kirkbymoorside Bowling Club.

John has been the green keeper and caretaker of the club since its inception in 1977. He has voluntarily maintained the Bowling Club grounds, enthusiastically and tirelessly over the past 45 years. KIRKBYMOORSIDE JUBILEE MEDAL

"We are pleased to announce that as part of the historic Platinum Jubilee Celebrations, the Kirkbymoorside History Group and Sylatech Ltd, with additional funding from Kirkbymoorside Town Council, have joined forces to design and produce a unique Jubilee Medal. We are extremely grateful to Sylatech for their generous support with this idea and for actually designing and creating the medal.

The idea for the jubilee medal came from other locally produced Victorian memorabilia and the aim was to create something unique to our town. Kirkbymoorside has a long tradition of manufacturing and engineering, and with a globally renowned investment casting company such as Sylatech in town, the project has become a reality.

The nickel-plated brass medal will be made available free to all children resident in Kirkbymoorside aged between 2 ½ years and 12 years, via their local pre-school, nursery and primary school. Anyone whose children are not enrolled at these places should get in touch with the History Group and register their child's eligibility, using the forms provided.

For anyone else wishing to purchase a medal, they will be on sale at the History Group display during the Memorial Hall Jubilee Celebrations, and will be on a strictly first-come, first-served basis as there is a limited supply."




KIRKBYMOORSIDE BOWLING CLUB
