

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR KIRKBYMOORSIDE TOWN COUNCIL
PLAY AREAS & SPORTS COMMITTEE

1. The Committee will be known as the PLAY AREAS AND SPORTS COMMITTEE. It will be a Committee of the Town Council.
2. The Play Areas & Sports Committee will be responsible for overseeing the general operation and maintenance of Old Road Play Area, Ryedale View Play Area and shall maintain in good order and manage the Sportsfield (on behalf of and within a budget fixed by the Town Council).
3. All voting members of the Committee, both Councillors and Co-optees, are subject to the "Model Code of Conduct" and should be aware of the contents of the Code, complete the Register of Interest and act accordingly.
4. The Committee will have the power to elect a chairman who will be elected at the first meeting.
5. The composition of the committee is to be 4 council members and up to 4 members of the public.
6. The quorum will be three members at least one of whom is a council member.
7. The Committee will be responsible for administering such lettings as are appropriate.
8. The Committee will have a budget set when the precept is determined.
9. The committee may authorise repairs to the facilities, equipment or replacement equipment provided that the cost is within the allocated budget.
10. The Committee may recommend to the Town Council the spending of such sums as it thinks fit on the improvement of the Play Areas and Sportsfield for items in excess of the allocated budget.
11. The Committee will submit its budget recommendations, to include income and expenditure and determine the amount, if any, to be obtained for the following financial year to the Finance Committee in November of each year. The Town Council will fix the budget for the following year and determine the amount, if any, to be obtained from Town Council resources. The Committee will be responsible for raising any additional funds.
12. The Committee will meet at least 4 times each year.
13. The Committee will follow the Council's Standing Orders for convening its meetings as those applied to meetings of the Full Council.
14. The Play Areas & Sports Committee will review its membership annually at the Annual Meeting of the Town Council in May.
15. The Play Area & Sports Committee will ratify its own minutes and then send these to Full Council for information only.
