KIRKBYMOORSIDE

Spring Series – is a series of informal orienteering events on varied terrain over three months. All events will take place on Saturday mornings – in Ryedale and Harrogate.

With an emphasis on informality, enjoyment and (as far as possible) in new terrain, the series will appeal to both experienced orienteers as well as newcomers.

Kirkbymoorside – Saturday 27th February 2016

Kirkbymoorside is rightly known as the “Gateway to the Moors”, and is a delightful small market town with a lovely range of shops, cafés and pubs along its picturesque Market Place – ideal for lingering after the event is over.

Orienteering assembly, pay and display parking and registration in public car park at the NW of the Market Place, just past the Kings Head Hotel on the left, YO62 6AT.

Terrain: Complex urban terrain, including a network of paths through a close-knit housing development.

Starts: from 11.00 to 12.30hrs. Courses close 13.00hrs

Courses: Beginners 0.8km, Improvers 1.8km, Stars 2.3km, Superstars 2.8km. Beginners course is suitable for unaccompanied juniors – no road crossings. Overprinted maps and SI punching. Course lengths subject to final controlling.

Map: 1:4000 map originally surveyed in Autumn 2012 but updated for this event by Tara and Anika Schwarze.

Fees: Seniors £5.00; Juniors £2.50. You can try any number of courses for one fee. SI dibber hire £1.00 for seniors and £0.50 for juniors. Lost hired SI Cards will be charged at £30.00.

Dogs: on lead in parking area only – not permitted on courses. Whistles recommended. Competitors take part at their own risk.
